1. Report on the Financial Statements

- ii. In the case of the Income & Expenditure Account of the deficit for the year ended on that date.

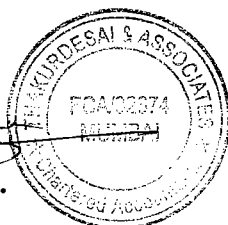

Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts

A. Accounting Policies:

1. Basis of Accounting

The accounts of the CSI, Vishakhapatnam Chapter are drawn up on historical cost and accrual basis.

2. Revenue Recognition

The membership Fees are recognized as and when it becomes due. Interest on Fixed Deposits of the Society is taken into account on an accrual basis during the Current year.

3. Fixed Assets.

- a) Flat at Dwarkanagar is recorded in the books of Headquarter and depreciation thereon is also been provided at Headquarters.
- b) Furniture & Fittings have been written off in the previous year.

4. Banks' Reconciliations:

The pending entries in the Banks' Reconciliations are required to be attended to.

5. Repairs & Maintenance:

Entire amount of Repairs & Maintenance for Flat at Dwarkanagar has been treated as Revenue Expenditure.
